The **Publications Editor** is responsible for overseeing the visual design of SCAD HoneyDripper's Zine development and bi-weekly newsletter. The Publications Editor ensures that publications have a strong, cohesive design aesthetic while maintaining content that is engaging and easy to read.

They work alongside HoneyDripper's Editor-in-Chief and Associate Editor to choose themes for each issue and oversee production. They organize each zine's design team and work with artists to create appropriate visual imagery for each story. This position qualifies for a monthly stipend.
